The Woods Hole Group recently completed the *Assessment and Analysis of Adaptation Alternatives for Coskata-Coatue Wildlife Refuge Properties* for The Trustees and the Nantucket Conservation Foundation. This report details the risk of breaching at several sites in the wildlife refuge and recommends several types of resilience actions that could be undertaken to reduce this risk. The Trustees and NCF would like to host a presentation by Woods Hole Group to local stakeholders to review the report findings. This would include a brief summary of conditions on the wildlife refuge, overview of the risks of sea level rise and erosion on potential breach sites, and a discussion of potential intervention options. This would be followed by a question and answer session and discussion of next steps.
