

**ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF NONVOTING TAXPAYERS**  
**Notes of meeting 10 A.M., SATURDAY, August 20, 2022 via Zoom**

1. Attending members: Kathy Baird, Gary Beller, Bill Gardner, Don Greene, Peter Halle, Peter Kahn and Bill Sherman; Member absent: Lou Bassano. Members of the public included Ted Bent, Franci Neely, and Jeff Parker. Guest Speaker Patrick Reed, Transportation Program Manager.
2. Chair Peter Halle opened the meeting at 10:03 a.m., read the script for Zoom meetings provided by the town and with a quorum present, the agenda for today's meeting and draft minutes for the August 6, 2022 meeting were both approved by roll call vote.
3. Peter welcomed guest speaker, Patrick Reed who provided brief introduction of his background and experience.
4. Peter opened the floor to members to share their thoughts on transportation issues and ask questions. Topics discussed included rotaries, public transportation, downtown parking, and excessive and increased traffic during the summer season.
5. Steve indicated that he hopes to facilitate dialogue, learn about and balance diverse interests within the somewhat limited ability to regulate things like traffic.
6. Public discussion was opened up for questions and comments to our guest speaker.
7. Gary Beller presented an overview of the Coastal Resiliency Advisory Committee (CRAC) from their final report and comments were entertained from the public.
8. After a brief discussion regarding the process and appointment of representatives to the town's Short Term Rental Working Group (STRWG), ACNVT unanimously approved three appointees: Peter Kahn (primary), Bill Gardner (alternate) and Gary Beller (second alternate).
9. Peter solicited and received feedback to be provided to Steve Arceneaux of the DPW.
10. A brief discussion regarding hybrid and fully virtual meetings going forward included concern about the current March 2023 expiration date of the Governor's Executive Order impacting ACNVT's ability to meet and weigh in on Annual Town Meeting issues.
11. The invited speaker for our September 3 meeting will be the newly elected Select Board Member, Brooke Mohr and a suggested speaker for later meetings is Alan Worden of the Nantucket Data Platform.

12. Public comment took place regarding a request from Franci Neely to poll non-voting taxpayers before taking a position on issues.
13. There was a motion, seconded and approved by roll call to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 11:56 a.m.
