TOWN AND COUNTY OF NANTUCKET OFFICES CLOSURE EXTENDED TO MONDAY, MAY 4, 2020

Dear Nantucket Community:

As of the Select Board’s April 1, 2020 meeting:

- Nantucket Town and County offices will remain closed to the public until **Monday, May 4, 2020** to be in compliance with Governor Baker’s Stay at Home Order amended on March 31, 2020.
- Only limited Town and County services will continue to be provided during this time.
- Nantucket Police and Fire Department facilities are closed to the public but providing full services.
- All schools are also closed until Monday May 4, 2020 per order of the Governor.
